Ditch and Water Right

To Whom it may concern:

Know ye that I Henry W. Coe of Skamania County, Washington, do hereby declare and publish as a legal notice to all the world, that I have a valid right to the occupation, possession and enjoyment of all and singular that tract and parcel of land lying and being in the St. Helens Mining District County of Skamania State of Washington for Ditch and Mining purposes. Bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

The Chicago N.W. Ditch. Head of ditch tapping the waters of the North Fork of the Tule River at a point indicated by a notice written on a hemlock tree on the North Bank of the River just above falls of said River, which are about 300 feet below the Chicago or Little Olaus Tunnel and about 300 feet North Eastward from the Hooper cabin. The course of the ditch hereafter will be such as to convey the water around the side of the Spirit Lake Range which is between the point of the proposed intake and the mine or lands of the Chicago North West Discovery claim, or such ditch may be constructed along the bank of said River as to permit the most advantageous use thereof. The said power to be used for Mining and Milling purposes. Said ditch to empty into River again after such use or for both of these purposes named. I also claim all of the waters of such stream not in excess of the maximum amount allowed by law to be conveyed by said ditch or ditches with the exclusive right of way for such ditch or ditches together with all and singular hereditaments and appurtenances therein to, belonging or in any way appertaining.
