Mill Site.

To Whom it may concern:

Know ye that I, Henry W. Coe of the County of Skamania Washington, do hereby declare and publish as a legal notice to all the world that I do have a valid right to the occupation, possession and enjoyment of all and singular that tract and parcel of land not exceeding 5 acres, situate, lying and being in the St Helens Mining District, County of Skamania, State of Washington, Bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

The Chicago North West Discovery Mill Site Beginning at larch tree 4 blazes 500 feet from the North East corner post #1 of the District Mining claim, upon the North East side line of said claim known as corner post #1. Thence running 800 North Easterly to a larch tree blazed upon 4 sides being the North East corner post and upon which is posted the location notice. Thence running 250 feet in a North Westerly direction to a larch tree blazed upon 4 sides being the North East corner post or post #3. Thence running South Westerly to a larch tree blazed upon 4 sides being the South West corner post or post #4. Thence South Easterly to place of beginning.

This claim is crossed near its center by the North Pugette River and is 1 mile North West of Mt. Rainier and about 600 feet N. East of the Broadbent cabin.
