NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That Clifford Bodda, of Carson, Skamania County, Washington, claims a lien upon approximately 2000 feet of piling and 40,000 board feet of logs, now located about $\frac{1}{4}$ (one-quarter) mile south of Home Valley, Skamania County, Washington, where Frank Birkenfeld and Ruth Birkenfeld, husband and wife, raft their logs and piling, and the said Clifford Bodda also claims a lien upon approximately 40,000 board feet of logs and 2500 lineal feet of piling located about three miles North of Home Valley, Skamania County, Washington, all of the above described logs and pilings being cut in Skamania County, Washington, and said lien being claimed for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in cutting and logging said logs and pilings; that the names of the owners or reputed owners are Frank Birkenfeld and Ruth Birkenfeld, husband and wife; that the said Frank Birkenfeld and Ruth Birkenfeld, husband and wife, employed the said Clifford Bodda to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said Frank Birkenfeld and Ruth Birkenfeld, husband and wife, agree to pay the said Clifford Bodda the sum of Four (\$4.00) Dollars per day for such labor and assistance; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said Clifford Bodda, who performed labor and assisted in the cutting of said logs and pilings for a period of approximately two (2) months; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon the said logs and pilings between the 25th day of April, 1935, and the 25th day of June, 1935; and the rendition of said service was closed upon the 25th day of June, 1935, and thirty (30) days have not elapsed since said time; that the amount of Claimant's demand for said service is One Hundred Six (\$106.00) Dollars; that no part thereof has been paid, except the sum of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and off-sets, the sum of Eighty-one (\$81.00) Dollars, in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs and pilings.

That the said Clifford Bodda claims a lien on all logs and pilings, now owned by the said Frank Birkenfeld and Ruth Birkenfeld, husband and wife, of said County, which are now in Skamania County, Washington, to secure payment for work and labor performed in secur-

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ing and obtaining the said logs and pilings herein described.
