To Whom it may Concern:

Know ye, that I Violet M. Coe, of Skamania County, Washington, do hereby declare and publish as a legal notice to all the world, that I have a legal valid right to the occupation, possession and enjoyment of all and singular that tract and parcel of land not exceeding (5) acres situate, lying and being in the St. Helens Mining District County of Skamania, State of Washington, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

The Virtue Mill Site Beginning at larch tree blazed on (4) sides 230 feet from the discovery post of the May Queen Lode on the North East side line of the Virtue claim and known as the South West corner post or post #1. Thence running North easterly 800 feet to a larch tree blazed on 4 sides being the North East corner post or post #2. Thence North West 250 feet to a hemlock tree, blazed upon 4 sides being the North West corner post or post #3. Thence South westerly 800 feet to a hornlock tree blazed upon 4 sides the South West corner post or post #4. Thence to point of beginning. Together with all and singular the accretions and appurtenances thereto belonging or appertaining to said claim. The North Fork of the Snake crosses this claim and it joins on its South West line the Virtue Mining claim and is about 600 feet N. East of the Broadbent cabin and about 1 mile N. West of Mt. Burnhardt.
