Mill Site

To Whom it may Concern:

Know ye that I Henry H. Goe of Skamania County, Washington, do hereby locate what is known as the May Queen Mill Site, beginning at the discovery point a hemlock tree blazed on (4) sides of the May Queen Lode, near the base of Violet Mountain, known as the South West corner post or post #1. Thence running 800 feet North westerly to hemlock tree blazed on 4 sides being the North East corner post or post #2. Thence 200 North Westerly to a hemlock tree blazed on (2) sides being the North West corner post or post #3. Thence South West 800 feet to a White Fir tree marked 4 blazes, being the South West corner post or post #4. Thence South Easterly 200 feet to point of beginning. This claim is bounded on its East side by Verlie Mill Site, on the South West side by May Queen Mining claim, on the N. West side by the Chicago N. West discovery and is situated about 600 feet North East from the Broadbent cabin which is near the tunnel of the Chicago N. West Discovery Mining claim. The claim is crossed by the North Fork of the Puget River and is about 1 mile North West of Mt. Rainier.
