


Elijah McKey & William P. MacLay to Chester F. Fowler.

and William P. MacLay do hereby constitute and appoint
Chester F. Fowler as our attorney in fact for us and
in our names to lease purchase or agree any mineral
lands belonging to the state of Washington, further more
to make application to the United States for the entry
and purchase of certain government lands in the afore-
said State known as mineral lands, and to have
the same surveyed and to take every and all steps
that may be necessary to procure from the government
of the United States a Patent to the said lands
and premises granting the same to us and to do all
other acts appertaining to the said survey and
entry aforesaid as we our selves could do by our
own proper persons in witness whereof we have
hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals.
