

THE U.S. TO BENJAMIN F. BLAISDELL.

Certificate No. 2366.

To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting:

Whereas, Benjamin F. Blaisdell of Skamania County, Washington Territory, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver Washington Territory, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Benjamin F. Blaisdell, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress Page 409 of 24th of April, 1820, entitled, "An Act making further provision for the Sale of the Public Lands", and the acts supplemental thereto, for the South West quarter of the North East quarter of Section, twelve, in Township Two North of Range Five East of Willamette Meridian, in Washington Territory, containing forty acres, according to the official Plat of the Survey of said Lands, returned to the General Land Office, by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Benjamin F. Blaisdell.

Now Know Ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such cases made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Benjamin F. Blaisdell and to his heirs, the said Tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Benjamin F. Blaisdell, and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of Courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.
