That there are no just credits and offsets to the amount above claimed and the whole thereof is justly due and owing. That said Harold Caldwell also claims a lien on all of the logs and wood owned by the said Shepardson of said Skamania County to secure the payment of his said work and labor in cutting and felling said logs and cord wood herein described.
