Notice is hereby given that Carl Krohn, of Skamania County, State of Washington,

claims a lien upon fourteen (14) rafts of logs, being about 750,000 feet in quantity which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, and are marked thus: B and are now lying in the Columbia River, approximately one-half mile Southwest of Stevenson, Washington, for labor performed and assistance rendered in cutting and rafting said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is T. A. Ryan. That T. A. Ryan employed said Carl Krohn to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

That the said T. A. Ryan agreed to pay said Carl Krohn for such labor and assistance the sum of One Hundred Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars per month; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Carl Krohn who performed labor upon and assistance in cutting and preparing said logs for market for a period of eight (8) months. That said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs between September 6, 1935 and the 6th day of May, 1936, and the rendition of said services was closed on the 6th day of May, 1936, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time.

That the amount of claimant's demand for said services is Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00) Dollars; that no part thereof has been paid and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00) Dollars, in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs.
