That said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs between September 6, 1935 and the 6th day of May, 1936, and the rendition of said services was closed on the 6th day of May, 1936, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time.

That the amount of claimant's demand for said services is Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00) Dollars; that no part thereof has been paid and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00) Dollars, in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs.
