The under signed claims the water in the Grizzley Creek in St. Helens Mining District, Okanogan Co. Washington, to the extent of 2500 inches per second of time. The said water right is situated about 9 miles north easterly from Mt. St. Helens, and is about 7000 feet from the mouth of said Grizzley Creek, where it empties into the north Bonthe river. Said water is to be used for mining and milling purposes, and to be conveyed by ditch or flume upon or near the mouth of said Grizzley Creek, and to be used for the Chicago Northwest, Number 1 and 2 claims in said district.
