

Andrew J. Anderson Wife to Eustav F. Anderson.

Power of Attorney.

This Indenture Witnesseth, That Andrew J. Anderson and Fannie E. Anderson his wife hereby constitute and appoint Eustav F. Anderson their attorney in fact, in their name, place and stead, to sell and convey the Tweedewasay Claim situated on what is known as Lake Canyon about one half mile from where it empties into Spirit Lake. The claim is more fully described as follows, to-wit: Beginning about Twenty five (25) feet North West of Lake Canyon where location note is posted, and running Fifteen Hundred feet in a South East direction, and Three Hundred feet on each side of the center of said vein, the discovery is about one half mile from Spirit Lake, and about one half mile below the Norway Camp on Lake Canyon in St. Helens Mining District, and duly recorded in Okanogan County in the State of Washington with full power to said Eustav F. Anderson as their attorney to do every thing they could in the premises, if personally present.
