

Octavia Mill Site. St. Helens Mining District.

Location Certificate of Mill Site.

To All Whom These Presents May Concern: Know ye, that we, W. A. Reynolds, David Stewart, and Dr. H. M. Lauman, all of the County of Lewis, state of Washington, do hereby declare and publish as a legal notice to all the world that we have a valid right to the occupation, possession and enjoyment of all and singular that tract or parcel of land, not exceeding five acres, situated, lying and being in St. Helens Mining District, county of Okanogan, state of Washington bounded and described as follows, to-wit: The Octavia Mill Site, beginning at the south east corner of the Octavia mining claim, location notice of which is recorded in the Auditor's office of said Okanogan county, Washington, in Book 5 of Miscellaneous records page 462, reference to which is here made for description of said mining claim; said beginning point, or corner is about 1223 feet more or less east, or in a nearly east course from United States Location Monument No. 2, of survey No. 621, of the Chicago & Northwest Discovery group of mining claims, plat of which is on file in the U. S. Land Office, Vancouver, Washington; from said beginning corner, thence in a northeasterly direction along the side line of said Octavia mining claim 217.8 feet; thence at right angle with said line in a northeasterly direction 1000 feet; thence at right angle with said last line in a southeasterly direction 217.8 feet; thence in a southeasterly direction at right angle with said last line, 1000 feet to place of beginning, containing five acres of land.
