

"The Copley Mill Site". St. Helens Mining District.

Location Certificate of Copley Mill Site.

To All Whom These Presents May Concern: Know ye, that we, W.A. Reynolds, David Stewart, and S. M. Lauman, all of the County of Lewis, State of Washington, do hereby declare and publish as a legal notice to all the world that we have a valid right to the occupation, possession and enjoyment of all and singular that tract or parcel of land, not exceeding five acres, situated, lying and being in the St. Helens Mining District, County of Skamania, State of Washington bounded and described as follows, to-wit: The Copley Mill Site, beginning at the Southeast corner of the Octavia mining claim, notice of location thereof recorded in the Auditor's office of said Skamania County, in Book X Miscellaneous records page 462, reference to which is here made for description of said mining claim; said beginning point, or corner is about 1223 feet more or less east, or nearly east from United States Location Monument No. 2, of survey No 621, Chicago Northwest Discovery group of mining claims, plat of which is on file in the U. S. Land Office, Vancouver, Washington; from said beginning corner, thence in a southeasterly direction parallel with the northeast side line of the Octavia claim, and along the northeast side line of the Copley claim 217.8 feet; thence at right angle with said last line in a northeasterly direction 1000 feet; thence at right angle with said last line in a northwesterly direction 217.8 feet; thence at right angle to last line in a southwesterly direction 1000 feet to place of beginning, containing five acres of land.
