That said T. W. Finnegan agreed to pay claimant twenty-seven cents per thousand feet for all logs bucked; and that claimant bucked 47,666 feet of logs of a value of \$13.35; and that claimant further performed service as filer at the request of said T. W. Finnegan at an agreed price of seventy-five cents per hour; and that he labored as such filer for a period of eighteen hours, earning \$13.50 therefore; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the claimant who performed labor upon and assisted in cutting said logs and as filer for a period of six days; that said labor and assistance was so performed and rendered upon said logs between the 26th day of July, 1936 and the 31st day of July, 1936; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 31st day of July, 1936; that thirty days have not el-

apsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said services is \$26.55; that no part thereof has been paid and that there is now due and unpaid after deducting all credits and offsets, the sum of \$26.55 to which amount claimant claims a lien upon said logs. The said claimant also claims lien on all logs now owned by said T. W. Finnegan in said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing said logs.
