The undersigned claims the water flowing in this stream (which is known as Box Canyon) to the extent of 150 cubic inches per second of time, to be conveyed by ditch or flume on to ground of the Wash Ireadwell, to be used for mining milling and manufacturing purposes.

The location has been made on top of the Falls of Box Canyon about 1 mile northeast of the old Samson camp and about 1/2 mile southeast from mouth of tunnel on Wash Ireadwell, and about 1 mile east from where creek runs into the North Tumble River.
