To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting: Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the register of the Land Office at Vancouver Washington whereby it appears that, pursuant to the act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain and the acts supplemental thereto the claim of Jacob Lee has been established and duly consummated in Conformity to law for the North half of the North East quarter of the North half of the North West quarter of Section eight in Township two North of Range five East of Willamette Meridian containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye That thereis, therefore granted by the United States unto the said Jacob Lee, the tract above described: To have and to Hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof unto the said Jacob Lee and to his heirs and assigns forever subject to any vested or accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, or other purposes and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of Courts and also subject to the right of the proprietor of any vein or lode to extract ^{and} remove his ore therefrom should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted as provided by law.
