CLAIM OF LIEN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That Tom W. Stults of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon four (4) rafts of logs being about 200, 90 foot pile, which were cut in Skamania County, State of Washington, are marked thus, (M), and are now lying in the Columbia River at Underwood, Skamania County, Washington, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in hauling said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is E. M. Reid; that E. M. Reid employed said Tom W. Stults to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said E. M. Reid agreed to pay the said Tom W. Stults for such labor and assistance the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) a day for driving truck; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Tom W. Stults, who performed labor upon and assisted in hauling said logs, three and one-half months; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs between the 29th day of July,

1936 and the 7th day of November, 1936, and thirty (30) days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for said service is Two Hundred Forty One & 60/100 Dollars; (\$241.60); that no part thereof has been paid except One Hundred Ten Dollars (\$110.00) and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of One Hundred Thirty One & 60/100 Dollars (\$131.60), in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs. The said Tom W. Stults, also claims a lien on all said equipment and trucks now owned by said E. M. Reid of said County to secure payment for the work and labor performed or obtaining or securing the said logs, piles or other timber herein described.
