

Notice of Location

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, a citizen of the United States over the age of Twenty-one years having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the local customs laws and regulations did on the 15th day of November 1897 locate a Lode Claim of 1500 x 600 feet situate in Skamania State of Washington and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Center of Florence Creek a tributary to the North Fork River about 1 mile South of the Chicago discovery and about 2000 ft Northwest of Lake Meta and about 600 ft above the "Mountain Fair" discovery in the St. Helens Mining district and shall be known as the South East discovery Claim of the "Mary" mine No 2.

From the discovery the Claim is running 1500 linear feet in a South Easterly direction and 300 feet on each side of Center of said River.

And that I intend to hold and work said above described Claim as provided by ^{the local} laws or regulations, and the customs and ruling of mining statutes and laws of the United States.
