JULIUS ORDWAY & WIFE to WASHUGAL LAND & LOGGING CO.

Know All men by these presents: That we Julius Ordway and June Ordway his wife of Portland Oregon, in consideration of Nine Thousand five hundred Dollars, to us paid by the Washugal Land and Logging Co. has bargained and sold and by these presents do hereby, grant, bargain, sell and convey to said Washugal Land and Logging Co. of La Camas Washington heirs and assigns forever the parcel of real estate situated lying and being in Skamania County, State of Washington, and bounded and particularly described as follows, to-wit: lots four, five, six and the south east quarter of the North west quarter of Section six (6) Township two North of Range six East, and the south east quarter, and the South half of the South west quarter and the North west quarter of the South west quarter, the west half of the North west quarter, the North East quarter of the North west quarter of Section (12) twelve, and the East half of the North East quarter and the North west quarter of the North East quarter, the North east quarter of the North west quarter and the South west quarter of the North west quarter the north west quarter of the South west quarter of Section (14) fourteen and the North half of the north half of section (24) Twenty-four Township two North of Range Five East of Willamette Meridian, containing, nine hundred and forty-nine and 85/100 acres. 
