

Polar Star Mill Site. Cascadia Mining & Development Co.

Location - Certificate - Mill-site.

To All Whom These Presents May Concern: Know ye that the undersigned corporation, the Cascadia Mining and Development Company, duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Washington, do hereby declare and publish as legal notice to the world that it has a valid right to the occupation, possession and enjoyment of all and singular that tract or parcel of land not exceeding five acres situate, lying and being in the St. Helens Mining District, Skamania County, Washington south of Goat Mountain, to-wit: the Polar Star Mill Site, beginning at post No. 1, which is identical with post No. 2 of the Black Falls Mill Site, which post is 750 feet in a north west direction from post No. 1 of the Black Falls Mill site, and the last named post is about 300 feet in a north west direction from Black Falls in the South Fork of Green river at the south east corner of the Phil Sheridan No. 1 mining claim which belong to this corporation; from point of beginning thence in a north west direction to stake No. 2; thence in right angle to last line in a south west direction 300 feet to post No. 3 of this mill site; thence in a south east direction at right angle with last line 750 feet to post No. 4, which is identical with post No. 3 of Black Falls Mill Site; thence in a north east direction at right angle with last line 300 feet to place of beginning, containing five acres.

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining.
