

Black Falls Mill Site - Cascadia Mining & Development Co.

To all Whom These Presents May Concern: Know ye that the undersigned corporation, the Cascadia Mining and Development Company, duly organized and existing under the laws of the state of Washington, do hereby declare and publish as legal notice to the world that it has a valid right to the occupation, possession, and enjoyment of all and singular that tract or parcel of land not exceeding five acres situate, lying and being in the St. Helens Mining District, County of Skamania, Washington situated on the south of Goat Mountain Summit: The Black Falls Mill Site, beginning at post No 1, which is at the south east corner of the Phil Sheridan No 1 mining claim belonging to this corporation which stake is about 300 feet in a north west direction from Black Falls in the North Fork of the Toutle River, or Greenriver; thence running in a north west direction and along the south west end line of said Phil Sheridan mining claim No 1, to stake No 2, which is 750 feet from Stake No 1; thence in a southwest direction at right angles with first line 300 feet to post No 3; thence at right angles with last line in a South east direction 750 feet to post No 4; thence in a northeast direction to place of beginning.
