

The Minnie Lee Mill Site. Cascadia Mining & Development Co.

Location Certificate of Mill-Site.

To all whom these presents may concern: Knowge that the undersigned, the Cascadia Mining and Development Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the state of Washington, do hereby publish and declare as legal notice to the world that it has a valid right to the occupation, possession and enjoyment of all and singular that tract or parcel of land not exceeding five acres, situated, lying and being in the St. Helens Mining District, county of Skamania, Washington, situated on the South of Coal Mountain town: The Minnie Lee mill site, beginning at post No. 1, which is about 100 feet north east of the Minnie Lee cabin and about 200 feet north west of the outlet of Dead Man Lake creek into the North Touth River and about 100 feet north of said North Touth; thence in a northwesterly direction 750 feet to stake No. 2; thence in a southwesterly direction 500 feet to stake No. 3; thence in a southeasterly direction 750 feet to a stake No. 4; thence in a northeasterly direction to place of beginning, containing five acres.

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining.
