Notice of Location "Blue Bird" Mining Claim

To whom it may concern:

Notice is hereby given that H. C. Coleman a citizen of the United States of America over the age of twenty one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other Mining Claims thereof and of the State of Washington and the local Customs, Laws, Rules and Regulations of said State, did on the 15th day of September A.D. 1898 locate and do hereby locate a Quartz Claim known as the "Blue Bird" lode or Mining Claim said claim having been discovered the 14th day of September 1898, and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein, bearing mineral in place, by five hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles and all other veins or lodes the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries situated in Lookout Mt. publicly locate a Quartz Claim for our use the Columbia

Eight hundred lineal feet on this lode or vein
