Notice is hereby given that Thomas Cogan of Stevenson, Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of saw logs, being about 250000 feet in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, and marked of which 50000 feet are now lying in the woodsnear the head of Little Carson Greek in Section 13 Twp., 5 N. R. 7 E. W. M. and 200000 feet of said logs in the Columbia River at Carson Landing in said County and State, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in logging said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is the said Dunlap & Finnegan; that they employed said Thomas Cogan to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:-

The said Donlap & Finnegan agreed to pay the said Thomas Cogan for such labor and assistance eighty cents per hour; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said claimant, who performed labor upon and assisted in logging said saw logs for the period of between July 12th, 1937 and the 4th day of August, 1937, and the rendition of said service was closed on the 5rd day of August, 1937 and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demant for said service is \$69.26; that no part thereof has been paid, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of 69.26, in which amount he claims a lien upon said saw logs. The said Thomas Cogan also claims a lien upon all said saw logs now owned by said Dunlap & Finnegan of said County to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining and securing the said saw logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.
