

Minnie Lee Mill Site, No. 1. St. Helens Mining Dist.

Location Certificate of Minnie Lee Mill Site, No. 1.

1/ To all whom these presents may concern: Know ye that the Cascadia Mining and Development Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the state of Washington, do hereby publish and declare as a legal notice to the world, that it has a valid right to the occupation, possession and enjoyment of all and singular that tract or parcel of land not exceeding five acres, situate, lying and being in the St. Helens Mining District, county of Skamania, Washington, lying on the south slope of Look Mountain, and known as the Minnie Lee Mill Site No. 1. Beginning at post No. 1, which is about 100 feet north east of the Minnie Lee mining cabin and about 200 feet north west of the outlet of Dead Man's Lake creek into the North Toutle river and about 100 feet north of said Toutle river; thence in a north-westerly direction 750 feet to stake No. 2; thence in a south-westerly direction 290.4 feet to stake No. 3; thence in a southeasterly direction 750 feet to stake No. 4; thence in a northeasterly direction 290.4 feet to place of beginning, containing five acres.
