

Minnie Lee Mill Site No. 2. St. Helens Mining Dist.

Location Certificate of Minnie Lee Mill Site No. 2.

To all whom these presents may come; Know ye that the Cascade Mining and Development Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the state of Washington is hereby published and declared as a legal notice to the world, that it has a valid right to the occupation, possession and enjoyment of all and singular that tract or parcel of land not exceeding five acres, situated, lying and being in the St. Helens Mining District, in Skamania County, State of Washington, lying on the South slope of Coal Mountain, and known as the Minnie Lee Mill Site No. 2 beginning at post No. 1, which is about 800 feet Northeast of the Minnie Lee mining cabin and about 950 feet Northwest of the outlet of Dead Man's Lake creek into the North Fork river and about 100 feet North of said Fork River, thence in a Northwesterly direction 700 feet to stake No. 2, thence in a Southwesterly direction 290.4 feet to stake No. 3, thence in a Southeasterly direction 700 feet to stake No. 4, thence in a Northeasterly direction 290.4 feet to the place of beginning, containing five acres.
