## NOTICE OF LIEN CLAIM

NOTICE is hereby given that the claimant named herein who has subscribed to this notice claim a lien upon a quantity of saw logs, part of which are marked with "X" on small end and part of which are unmarked, there being about 270,000 feet in the Columbia River at Carson boat landing approximately one mile west of Wind River, and approximately one mile west of Wind River, and approximately 900,000 feet lying in the woods in Sec. 13 T. 3 N. R. 7 E. W.M., all being in Skamania County, State of Washington, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in securing, cutting, bucking, logging, manufacturing and hauling the said logs as hereinafter set forth.

That the name of the owner or reputed owner is E. E. Dunlap and P. J. Finnegan, co-partners, d.b.a. Dunlap & Finnegan, and such labor and assistance was performed at the request of the said owners; that the terms and conditions of the employment of the claimant, together with the amount of his claim, is as follows:

That A. L. Dunlap was employed setting choker and driving cat a period of 307 hours at 75¢ per hour. That the said labor commenced on the 8th day of May, 1937, and ended on the 7th day of August, 1937. The total amount of claimant's lien is the sum of \$230.25 of which there has been paid the sum of \$45.19, leaving a balance of \$185.06 for which amount he claims a lien against the above described logs.

That the above stated balance is due and unpaid and there are no just credits or offsets against the same except as shown herein.

That not more than thirty days have elapsed since the closing of said services and labor of said claimant above named and that said claimant is entitled to and hereby claims a lien in the amount of the balance due as above set out against all the logs and timber products above described. That the said claimant also claims a lien upon all of the saw logs and timber products now owned by said E. E. Dunlap and P. J. Finnegan, co-partners, d.b.a. Dunlap & Finnegan, in said county to secure payment for work and labor performed in obtaining and securing said logs and other timber products herein described.
