Notice of location of Water right.

We the undersigned who are citizens of the United States hereby declare and give notice to all persons concerned that they do hereby claim in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington 300 miners inches of water to be taken from Rock Creek Okanogan County Wash at a point about 18 miles above the mouth of said Creek and at the top of the sixth fall where a copy of this notice or statement has been posted and we intend to hold this water for the purpose of milling or smelting ore or for any other purpose required in working the Quarry Mining Claim known as the Ida Belle Quarry Mining Claim. said water to be taken out by means of a flume.
