And be it known that these presents do Revoke, Recall and Countermand and to all intents and purposes make null and void and of no effect a certain Power of Attorney, made and executed on the Twenty ninth day of December in the Year One thousand eight hundred and ninety one, whereby Robert Livingstone and W. B. Gilbert both of Portland Oregon, were nominated, constituted and appointed by the said Company as its true and lawful Attorneys for it and in its name, place and stead in the States of Oregon, Washington and Idaho.
