NOTICE OF LIEN CLAIM

NOTICE is hereby given that the claimants named herein who have subscribed to this notice claim a lien upon a quantity of saw logs, part of which are marked with "X" on small end and part of which are unmarked, there being about 270,000 feet in the Columbia River at Carson boat landing approximately one mile west of Wind River, and approximately 900,000 feet lying in the woods in Sec. 13 T. # N. R. 7 E. W.M., all being in Skamania County, State of Washington. for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in cutting, bucking, logging and hauling the said logs as hereinafter set forth.

That the name of the owner or reputed owner is E. E. Dunlap and P. J. Finnegan, co-partners, d.b.a. Dunlap & Finnegan, and such labor and assistance was performed at the request of the said owners; that the terms and conditions of the employment of each of the claimants, together with the amount of their respective claims, are as follows;

J. Rasmussen was employed as hook tender at the agreed price of \$1.00 per hour for 48 hours work and \$1.25 per hour for 60 hours work. That his services as such hook tender for the above owners commenced on July 3, 1937 and ended on the 7th day of August, 1937 and that said work and labor was done upon said logs during the above mentioned period. That the amount of claimant's demand is the sum of \$148.00 of which there has been paid the sum of \$2.05, leaving a balance of \$145.95 over and above all just credits and offsets and that the same is now unpaid and for which sum he claims a lien against said saw logs.

Vern Eckart was employed as signal man at the agreed price of 50¢ per hour for 131 hours. That he commenced said work and services on July 3rd, 1937, and that the same were ended on the 7th day of August, 1937. That the total amount of claimant's demand is the sum of \$65.50 of which there has been paid the sum of \$19.30, leaving a balance due and unpaid to claimant the sum of \$45.20 over and above all just credits and offsets and for which sum he claims a lien against said saw logs.

E. Rhodes was employed as choker setter at the agreed price of 68-5/4 cents per hour for 74 hours work. That his services as such choker setter commenced on July 24, 1937 and ended on August 7, 1937, and that said work and labor was done upon said logs during the above mentioned period. That the amount of claimant's demand is the sum of \$46.62 of which there has been paid the sum of \$7.26, leaving a balance of \$39.36 over and above all just credits and offsets and that the same is now unpaid and for which sum claimant claims a lien against said sawlogs.

That said claimants are entitled to and hereby claim a lien in the amount of the balance due as above set out against all the logs and timber products above described. That the said claimants also claim a lien upon all of the saw logs and timber products now owned by said E. E. Dunlap and P. J. Finnegan, co-partners, d.b.a. Dunlap & Finnegan, in said County to secure payment for work and labor performed in obtaining and securing said logs and other timber products herein described.
