This water is appropriated for the purpose of fluming lumber cord-wood etc and for irrigating such lands as ~~are~~ along the course of said stream. when ~~it is~~ and which may be made susceptible to irrigation. This water is to be diverted by means of a flume and from the point of diversion a cliff of Rock bears S 56.00 East 15 feet distant the point of diversion being within the measured territory of Township 4 South Range 10 East. October the 15th 1902.
