I know it well by these Presents, that I, the undersigned, have this 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1903 claimed the water running, flowing and being from the Spring lying about 300 feet and in a northeasterly direction from the Northwest corner of a tract of land, formerly being a part of the Findley Donation Land Claim and now belonging to Hadley & Hayes, comprising 40 acres more or less. The water from said spring will be conveyed by flume, ditch or pipe to the extent of one cubic foot per second of time and for the purpose of irrigating, furnishing supply for houses and furnishing power for the Collins Hot Springs and houses belonging thereto.
