NOTICE OF CLAIM OF LIEN.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That A. E. Majors and E. A. Holbrook, co-partners, of Yale, Cowlitz County, State of Washington, claim a lien upon a certain raft of logs, being about 9,000 in quantity, which were cut and manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, and are marked thus: with plain two inch circle brand, also plain "V" brand, all logs containing same brand, and are now lying in the waters of the Columbia River at Knappton, Pacific County, State of Washington; in the slough at Woodland, Cowlitz County, Washington, and in the log pond of the M&M Plywood Company at Longview, Cowlitz County Washington; for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in yarding and loading said logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Fred Dixon; that he employed the said A. E. Majors and E. A. Holbrook to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said Fred Dixon agreed to pay the said A. E. Majors and E. A. Holbrook, co-partners, for such labor and assistance in yarding and loading said logs, the sum of \$3.00 per thousand; that said contract has been faithfully ^{performed} and fully complied with on the part of said A. E. Majors and E. A. Holbrook; they performed said labor upon and assisted in obtaining said logs for a period of four months; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said logs between the 9th day of June, 1937, and the 6th day of October, 1937; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 6th day of October, 1937, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is for assisting in the manufacture of 1,700,000, less 5% of said scale at the rate of \$3.00 per thousand, being in the total sum of \$4850.00; that no part thereof has been paid except the sum of \$3000.00, and that there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets the sum of \$1850.00, in which amount they claim a lien upon said logs.
