To Whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given that Emory Oliver, of Portland Oregon hereby claims and appropriates the water lying, being or flowing in the Little White Salmon River, in Multnomah County State of Washington to the extent of Five Hundred (500) cubic Feet of water per second of time.

The point for diverting said water from said Little White Salmon River being in the North West Quarter of Section One (1) in Township Three (3) North Range Nine (9) East Willamette Meridian. The purpose for which said water is claimed and appropriated, is for domestic, irrigation and manufacturing purposes, and the place of intended use is on the property owned or controlled by said Emory Oliver in Township 3 North Range Nine East Willamette Mer. That the means by which it is intended to divert the water from said stream is by head-gate or dam, and said water is to be conveyed from the point of diversion to the place of intended use by means of a ditch, flume or pipe of sufficient size and carrying capacity to carry all of said

water to the point of intended use.
