

Articles of Incorporation of The Underwood Mining Company

I, the undersigned men by these presents, That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation, under the laws of the State of Washington. And we hereby certify: First. The corporate name of this Corporation is The Underwood Mining Company. Second. The purposes for which this Corporation is formed, are to carry on the business of mining for gold, silver and other metals in the County of Skamania and State of Washington. Third. The amount of the capital stock of this Corporation shall be Ten Thousand (10,000) Dollars, divided into One Hundred (100) shares, of the par value of One Hundred (100) Dollars each. Fourth. The term for which this Corporation is to exist is fifty (50) years from and after the date of its incorporation. Fifth. The number of Trustees shall be Three, and the names and residence of those who are appointed for the first six (6) months are: - Amos Underwood, Underwood, Skamania County, Wash. Edward Underwood, Underwood, Skamania County, Wash. Edward A. Sweetland, Cascade Locks, Wasco County, Oregon. Sixth. The principal place of business of this Corporation is Underwood Landing, County of Skamania, and State of Washington.
