Notice is hereby given that Rudolph Hegewald and Norman Risjord, d.b.a. Hegewald & Risjord, of Skamania County, State of Washington, claim a lien upon a quantity of saw logs, being about 138000 feet which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, Washington, and are marked thus \_\_\_\_\_, and are now lying in the Columbia River or water tributary thereto, the exact place being to claimants unknown, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in yarding said logs with a CAT; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Long Bell Lumber Co., of Longview, Washington; that said claimants were employed to perform such labor, and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said Krohn & Aalvik agreed to pay the said claimants for such labor and assistance \$1.35 per thousand feet; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said claimants, who performed labor upon and assisted in yarding said logs for the period of 129 hours; that said labor and assistance were so rendered and performed upon said logs between February 24th, 1938 and the 25th day of June, 1938; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 24th day of June, 1938, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for said service is \$569.00; that no part thereof has been paid except \$413.00, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$156.00, in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs. The said claimants also claim a lien on all said logs now owned by said debtors to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing said logs, spars, piles or other timber herein described.

STATEMENT AND CLAIM OF LIEN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State of Washington through its Department of Labor and Industries claims a lien prior to all other liens, except taxes, upon any and all of the real estate, plant, works, equipment and buildings improved, operated or constructed by the above named employer and also upon any and all logs, spars, piles, ties and any and all other timber produced, and any and all articles manufactured by said above named employer, which property is now located in County of Skamania, State of Washington, and is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Approx. 200,000 feet board measure, Douglas fir, white fir and hemlock of approx. 250 logs 8 - 50" diameter - 15' to 60' long in raft in Columbia River near mouth of Duncan Creek below Butlers Eddy, south of Skamania post office, Skamania County, State of Washington.

2 sets of fir boomsticks with chains, lines and loggles.

1 No. 40 International Diesel Tractor No. 40138, Type TB AW with lines hooks and chokers located near the banks of the Columbia River on Walker Place, south of Skamania Post Office in Skamania County.

1 loading engine - gas driven tract No. 40 Monarch with lines, blocks hooks and tackle.

Logging blocks and trailers used in logging operation.

Logging equipment, blocks, lines, wire rope, shieves, drums, peavies, axes, used in logging operation.

This lien is upon, and to secure the payment of, an account of and for industrial insurance and medical aid premiums or assessments and penalties due the industrial insurance and medical aid funds of the State of Washington, all of which aggregate (\$502.88) Dollars, and all of which were incurred under and by virtue of the operations of said employer in which workmen were employed under the provisions of section 7673 to 7796, inclusive, of Remington's Compiled Statutes.

This lien shall date from the commencement of the labor for and on account of which said premiums or assessments and penalties are due, to-wit: April 1, 1933.

The said employer made report to the Department of Labor and Industries of his pay
