

Notice of Location "Golden Rod" mine

To whom it may Concern:

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned a citizen of the United States of America, over the age of Twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws, mining laws of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did on the 12th day of September A.D. 1898 locate and by this notice do hereby locate a Discovery Claim known as the Golden Rod mine, lode or mining claim said claim having been discovered the 12th day of September 1898. And do claim (seven hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein, bearing mineral in place by six hundred in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) (twenty acres of placer mining ground) situated in Lookout Mining District, County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:
