WELDON TO BERT THOMPkins ET AL.

Notice is hereby given that C.L. Weldon, of Skamania County, State of Washington claims a lien upon a quantity of ties, being about 1200 in number, which were cut and manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, which are not married and are piled on the right of way of the S.P. & S. Ry. Company, at Cascades Washington, about 45 rods west of the water tank of said Railway company; also upon a quantity of saw logs cut in said Skamania County, and being about 122,000 feet in quantity, and now lying in Skamania County, Washington upon Kilgore claim, at the mill operated by the said---Samuels, Thompkins and Samuels; for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in cutting and manufacturing said ties, and cutting said logs; that the name of the owners, or reputed owners are---Samuels, Bert Thompkins and William Samuels; the said said owners employed said claimant to perform such labor and render

such assistance upon the following conditions, to-wit:

First the said owners agreed to pay the said C.L. Weldon for such labor and assistance the sum of \$2.50 per day; that the said contract has been fully performed and complied with on the part of said claimant, who performed labor upon and assisted in cutting and manufacturing said ties and logs for the period of 19¹/₂ days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said ties and logs between the 19th day of January 1915 and the 14th day of February, 1915; and rendition of said service was closed upon the 14th day of February, 1915, and 30 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for said services is \$48.75, and that no part thereof has been paid except \$12.45, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$36.30 in which amount he claims a lien upon said ties and logs. The said C.L. Weldon also claims a lien on all said ties and logs now owned by said ---Samuels, Bert Thompsons and William Samuels in said County to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining and securing the said ties and logs herein described.
