

Notice of Location The Iron Cap Lode & its Claim No. 1

Notice is hereby given, that the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Twenty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the local customs, laws and regulations have located 1500 X 600 feet on the Iron Cap Lode situated in H. Nelson's Mining District State of Washington and described as follows:
Location Notice mailed in Tin Can mailed to Dec cover post.

Beginning at the discovery situated about 150^{feet} East of the Third Tunnel North and up Montana Gulch and about 750 North from the South East End of the Montana Lode Claim. Discovery stake and notice is on top of the ridge East of Montana Gulch, the Iron Cap Lode Claim runs diagonally across the South East ends of the Montana Lode Claim and the Copper Queen Lode Claim, beginning at discovery and running 750 feet North and 45° West magnetic to center or end post, and 750 feet South 45° East to center or end post, thence 300 feet at right angles from each center or end posts to corner posts at each corner is situated on the South side of the Mountain and covers 1500 X 600 of Montana Gulch, formerly known as Tamsen Gulch, and was once known as a part of the Tamsen Group of Claims will be hereafter known as the Montana Group, was discovered and located in 1895 became delinquent in 1897 and is now re-located October 22nd 1898 by the undersigned including all dikes spur cracks angles and parallels and all other appurtenances and variations
