

Notice of Location "The Copper Bronze" Lode

The Copper Bronze Lode Discovery Claim No. 7, S. W.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having complied with the requirements of Chapter six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the local customs laws and regulations has located 1500 X 600 linear feet on the Copper Bronze Lode situated in Sh. 17 Elmwood Mining District, State of Washington and described as follows: Location postcard placed in the Can mailed to Center post,

Beginning at the 100 corner situated at the entrance of what was once known as the Samson prospect tunnel location, Notice placed in the same ten Can with the Montana location. The north west end of the Copper Bronze Lode begins at the South East end of the Montana Lode claim and runs 1500 linear feet North 45° East magnetic to Center or End take or the corner. Three hundred feet at right angles on each side from each center take to corner state at each 4 corners, embracing 1500 X 600 feet and includes the ground so formerly known as the Samson Camp, was discovered in 1895 by claim belonging in 1897 and was a part of the Samson deposit of claims and is now re-located by the undersigned and will hereafter be known as a part of the Montana group so situated at what is properly the lower end of what was once known as Samson Gulch is on the south side and near the base of Star Mountain of which forms the East end of Goat Mountain Range.
