 as Samson Gulch. was discovered in 1895
 and became delinquent in 1897 and is now
 located by the undersigned on Oct 22nd 1898
 is situated on the South side of Star Mountain
 and is on the North side of the North Fork
 River and was a part of the Samson Group
 will be hereafter known as the Montana Group,
 is about 100 feet up the gulch and North
