The Glory Mundy Made Discovering Claim No 1

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having complied with the requirements of Chapter Five of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the local customs, laws and regulations has located 1500 x 600 linear feet on the Glory Mundy Made situated in the Helena Mining District, Blaine County, State of Washington and described as follows:

Beginning at the Discovering at the entrance of what was once known as the Galandrie Tunnel, Commences at corner placed in tin can nailed to the post set for discovering post, and running 150 feet each way from Discovering corner to center or end stakes and 300 feet on each side of center line boundary lines marked by center line and end lines, at each end of center line 4 corner posts and 3 center line posts one at each end and one at the center at discovering is situated about 1/2 a mile South East of what was once known as the Montana Camp, will be hereafter known as the Montana Camp grounds was discovered 1895 became delinquent 1897 was relocated and again became vacant for the lack of survey for 1 month. Is now relocated by the undersigned, and surveyed and properly marked is included in the Montana Group.

Including all dips, spurs, cracks, angles and parallels and all other appurtenances and variations.
