The Montana Lode Discovery Claim No 1 North,

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the local customs, laws and regulations has located 1500 Linear feet on the Montana Lode situated in St Helens Mining District Kamiah County State of Washington and described as follows: Location placed in tin can nailed to center post.

Beginning at the discovery situated on Montana Gulch, notice placed at the right hand side of the entrance of Prospect Tunnel formerly known as James Prospect Tunnel beginning at notice by and running Fifteen Hundred Linear feet North, 80° West Magnetic to Center or end Post, and Three Hundred feet on each side of center line to Corner stakes at each four corners, and properly marked

Is described as being what was once known as the first Discovery Lode of the James Group, discovered in '95 and became delinquent in '97 and was relocated by the undersigned in 1898 is situated on the South side of Star Mountain. Including all dips, springs, cracks and angles and parallels and all other effects and variations
