The Garnet Lode, Discovering Claim No. 1 West,

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having complied with the requirements of Chapter 38 of Title Twenty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the local customs laws and regulations has located 1500 x 600 linear feet on the Garnet Lode situated in St. Helens Mining District, Harney County, State of Washington and described as follows:

Beginning at the Discovering situated on Montana Gulch and running 1500 linear feet including 300 feet on each side of center line boundary lines marked by center lines running from Discovering 1500 linear feet North 80° West Magnetic to West end corner stake, thence 600 feet at right angles from each end on center stake to each corner stake, is situated on what was once known as Jansen Gulch was discovered in 1895 and became delinquent in 1897 and is now located by the undersigned Oct the 20th 1898. Is situated on the south side of Star Mountain and is on the north side of the North Fork River and was once part of the Jansen Group, will be hereafter known as the Montana Group, is situated about 600 feet up the Gulch and north of the Montana Lode including all dips, spans, angles and parallels and all other offsets and variations.
