performed and assistance rendered in hauling said ties that the name of the that Isadore St. Martin a contractor employed by D.E. Smith owner or reputed owner is D.E. Smith, employed said Chas. Dupree to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions to wit: The said Isadore St. Martin agreed to pay the said Chas. Dupree for such assistance the sum of five dollars per day for himself and team or two dollars and fifty cents for himself without team and five cents for each tie hauled when hauling by the piece. That said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said Chas. Dupree who performed labor upon and assisted in hauling said ties for the period of thirty two days and one half day with team and five days and $\frac{3}{4}$ of one day without team and 495 ties at at 5 cents each piece work/. that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said ties between the tenth day of July and the eleventh day of Sept 1915 and the rendition of said service was closed on the eleventh day of September, 1915 and thirty days have not elapsed since that time. That the amount of claimants demand for said service is two hundred dollars and eighteen cents that no part thereof has been paid except thirty dollars and 25 cents for board and forty dollars cash and forty cents comisary and twenty nine dollars for horse fee d and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets the sum of One hundred dollars and fifty three cents (\$100.53) in which amount he claims a lien upon said ties the said Chas. Dupree also claims a lien on all said ties now owned by said D.E. Smith and Isadore St. Martin of said county to secure the payment for the work and labor performed in hauling said ties.
