NOTICE OF CLAIM OF LIEN.

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 25th day of August, 1915, at the request of H.L. Goodwin, for himself and as agent for Ellis & Snyder, the above named claimant commenced to perform labor for the above named H.L. Goodwin and Ellis & Snyder, co-partners, in the operation of their saw mill located at what is known as George's Spur upon the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Company's line of railway in Skamania County, Washington, which said George's Spur is about ten miles west of the station known as White Salmon upon said Railway.

That this claimant worked for a period of 6 days and 8 hours during said month of August, 1915, and worked for a period of 27 days during the month of September, 1915, making a total of 33 days and 8 hours at the agreed price of \$2.50 per day, amounting to \$84.50;

That this claimant left said employment on September 29th, 1915, and that ninety (90) days have not expired since last said date; that no part of said sum of \$84.50 has been paid except the sum of \$27.50, leaving a balance due thereon in the sum of \$57.00;

For which <sup>said</sup> labor so performed the undersigned claims a prior lien upon the property hereinafter described and upon the buildings situated therein for said sum of \$57.00, to-wit:

Upon all of the real property upon which said saw mill is located at said George's Spur; and also claiming a prior lien on the franchise and earnings of said H.L. Goodwin and Ellis & Snyder, co-partners, and the following personal property; to-wit: One Hundred Fifty Thousand feet of lumber more or less located at said mill, said lumber being mostly one and two inch, random length and four to fourteen inches in width, also some three and four inch lumber and also some railroad ties, intending hereby to include all lumber now located in and upon the yards of the above described mill.
