

Notice of Location

The Vauclait Lode Mining Claim
 M^c Army Mining District
 Klamath County State of Washington

The undersigned who are citizens of the United States hereby declare and give notice to all persons concerned, that they have discovered a vein or lode within the limits of the Claim hereby located and in paid lode a vein or crevice of quartz or ore with at least one well-defined wall, and that they have this 21st day of August A. D. 1897, located and do hereby locate and Claim under and by virtue of Chapter Six, Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the laws amendatory thereto and the laws of the State of Washington, a mining claim upon said lode or vein to be designated and named the Vauclait Quartz Lode Mining Claim extending along said lode or vein 500 feet in a southerly direction from the center of the discovery shaft (in which shaft this notice and statement is posted) and 300 feet on each side from the middle or center of said lode or vein at the surface comprising in all 1,500 feet in length along said lode or vein and 600 in width with all the rights and privileges as to surface ground and lodes veins or ledges within the boundaries of said Claim and otherwise and the metals minerals and valuable deposits of every kind contained in said veins lodes or ledges or within said boundaries which are given or allowed by the laws of the United States approved or of the State of Washington.

The Mining Claim hereby located situated in the M^c Army Mining District Klamath County Washington and is the Original Discovery Claim

This location is distinctly marked on the ground so that its boundaries can be readily traced by a Post set at Discovery shaft when this notice and statement is posted this 21st day of August A. D. 1897

and by substantial posts or monuments of stone at each corner of the claim; and the exterior boundaries of the claim as marked by said posts or monuments, are as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at Receiver's Shaft where this notice is posted running thence 300 feet in a North-westerly direction to the N.W. Corner post, thence in a Southerly direction 1500 ft to S.W. Corner post thence 600 ft in a South-Easterly direction to S.E. Corner Post, thence 1500 ft in a North Easterly direction to N.E. Corner Post thence 300 ft in a North-westerly direction to place of beginning, the claim is located on unsurveyed land, and am unable to give a direct course of boundary lines except by boundary posts or monuments.

The undersigned intend to hold this claim under and according to the Laws of the United States and the State of Washington and to record this Notice and Statement under such in the County Auditor's Office of said County as provided by law
