NOTICE OF CLAIM OF LIEN.

Notice is hereby given that W. Mosher, Claims a lien upon the Property herein described as follows. to-wit:

One logging donkey, Willamette, one saw mill including two boilers, one Atlas engine, two conveyers, one Audley carriage, two 56 inch ATKINS saws, one 48 inch Atkins saw, one 42 inch Atkins trimmer saw, one Mississippi edger, one log haul, one planer, one blower and all shafting, belting, gearing and all other machinery of any kind or nature used in the operation of said saw mill, also all tools used in blacksmith shop, one small office building, two bunkhouses, one cook house, all of said property being situated on Lot One (1) Section Thirty two (32) township three (30), North of Range Nine (9) East of W.M. and at what is known as George's Spur on the line of the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company in Skamania County, State of Washington, together with all the franchises, rights and accounts of said parties.

That the said lien is claim for labor in the operation of said mill running an edger therein and in the repairing of the machinery in said mill.

That the owner, or reputed owner, of said property so described is H. L. Goodwin, and that the said H. L. Goodwin, employed said claimant to perform said labor and to render said assistance in the operation of said sawmill upon the following terms and conditions to-wit: that the said W. Mosher, the claimant herein was to work running an edger in said mill and to work in the repairing of the machinery therein and that the said H. L. Goodwin was to pay claimant at the rate of \$2.50 per day, for said labor so performed.

That the said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with by the said claimant, who performed labor in the operation of said mill as follows commencing on the 1st day of July, 1915: worked in the month of July, 1915, 3 days, repairing machinery, and 18 days running the edger, in the month of August, 1915, 2 days repairing machinery, and 19 days running the edger, in the month of September, 1915, 8 days, repairing machinery, 17½ days running the edger, in the month of October, 1915 three (3) days repairing machinery, 6½ days running the edger; that the rendition of said labor closed on the 12th day of October, 1915, and that the total time of said labor amounted to 77 days; that the amount of claimant's demand for such services is \$192.50, and that no part thereof has been paid save the sum of \$44.57, and that there is now due and owing to said claimant after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$147.93, in which said sum the claimant claims a lien upon all the property heretofore described; that ninety days have not elapsed since the cessation of said labor, and that all of said labor was performed within a period of six (6) months next preceeding the filing of this lien.
