

Notice of Location of "Hard Cash" mining claim

Notice is hereby given that I the undersigned having complied with Chapter six Sec 32 of the Revised Statutes and local customs laws and regulations, have this 10th day of November 1898, locate 1500 Lateral feet on this vein which will be known as the "Hard Cash" situated in Copper Creek Mining District Skamania County State of Washington the same being an abandoned claim and more particularly described as follows: situated on a tributary of Copper Creek known as Rosler Creek. beginning at North end center stake, running in a South Easterly direction 1500 feet to S. Easterly direction to West corner stake thence 300 feet in a S. Westerly direction to S. W. corner stake.
